Willie Lee Robinson was born on September 22, 1952 in Hughes, AR to his parents, James and Arlene Robinson. There were twelve children born to this union. While attending Risco High School, he took an Auto Mechanic Class which led him to developing a passion for working on cars. As he learned more skills, he started repairing on family, friends and neighbor's cars in Malden.
