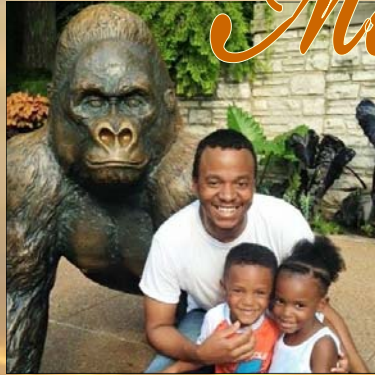

## Life Reflections

**ERIC CARTER GREEN, JR.**, lovingly called “Mister” by his family, was born June 19, 1985 in Yokosuka, Japan to the union of Eric C. Green and Glenda A. Green. He was the second of two children born of this union. As a “Military Brat”, Eric experienced life in various parts of the world. He attended DGF Grade School in Rota, Spain where he played sports and met his two best friends. Later, the Green family relocated to Memphis, TN where Eric attended Munford High School and graduated in 2003. Eric furthered his education at the University of Tennessee Martin where he obtained a degree in Business Administration with a minor in Economics in 2007.

Eric (Mister) Green developed a passion for God and people and was baptized at a young age. His spiritual journey included time at the 31st Street SDA Church in San Diego, CA and the Word of Life SDA Church in Memphis, TN. Eric would later move to St. Louis, MO to establish a relationship with the family he missed growing up around but soon gained new family in the form of The Lighthouse SDA church (a merger between formerly known Emmanuel SDA Church and New Life SDA Church). Being a man of many passions, he was not only a presence in the church but in the community as well. He was an active participant in various groups, lending his voice to the cause for others. Such groups included the “Pot Bangers”, ‘Young Voices with Action’, Double Impact, FuZion, Peacekeepers, and M.E.N. Eric never forgot that his main reason for being in St. Louis was to carry out God’s Great Commission found in Matthew 28:19 & 20.

Although his life was filled with great adventures and great friends, something was missing. While being actively involved in ministry, Eric met Shamone Mitchell.
